

# OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, 40 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: 59/OFF/075/2018

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **WINE PLUS GIFTS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to deliver alcohol from the premises situated at **25 Faulks Drive, Lincoln** and known as "**WINE PLUS**", to any person for consumption off the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS – SECTION 116 (2)

- (a) No Alcohol may be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day or contrary to sections 49 or 59 (1) of the Act.
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday from 7.00am to 9.00pm**

- (c) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
- Alcohol must only be sold and supplied within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

## ENDORSEMENT – SECTION 40

- (e) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on any receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
- 1) The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
  - i) A legible image of the licence, or clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- (h) The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
- 1) In the case of an order made using an internet site the prospective buyer must declare by ticking an on screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age (and where the prospective receiver is involved, that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) –
    - i) Once when the prospective buyer first enter the internet site; and
    - ii) Again, immediately before the sale of any alcohol is completed.

## THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises situated at 25 Faulks Drive, Lincoln are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee on the 18<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

## DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Faulks Drive, Lincoln is designated as the principal entrance.

## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements above, **the licence expires on the 08<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020**, unless again renewed.
